


YOUR CHARITY \$\$\$... WHERE AND HOW FAR DO THEY GO?





95% to Bangladesh... In Australia Fred Hyde Schools is totally staffed by volunteers.

In Bangladesh.... Just 6% is spent on administration, the rest is used for our core purpose...running 40 primary schools and 18 kindergartens to provide precious education for the children.

WHAT WE DO

Education gives children a chance at a better life, wherever they are born. In rural Bangladesh, education enables children to make choices that their illiterate parents could never have made.

Our 40 schools and 18 pre-schools are located in the villages and rice paddies of Bhola Island, a large remote mud island in the Ganges river where very poor people live.





We employ 175 dedicated teachers in our schools.

Some teachers are employed on the outlying islands – yes, even more remote than Bhola Island. We pay them a small "remote" allowance. We have a team of relief teachers to cover leave.

There is an administration team of 7, one located in Dhaka, the others in the main office.

On average, it costs only AUD\$78 a year to educate one student.

Repair and replace an existing school

The old tin schools Fred Hyde built in the 90s have suffered the ravages of time and the elements. We have begun replacing those schools, but with bricks, concrete, electricity, fans and insulation, to make the learning more comfortable. School equipment (tables, chairs, cupboards, resources etc) is constantly in need of replacement. Books are provided free by the Bangladesh Government. It costs, on average, AUD\$18000 to completely replace a school. A yearly donation of AUD\$1000 would ensure a school's equipment is kept up to date.
